Uniform Policy:

The school uniform is available to buy online or instore from O'Reilly's sports, Ballybofey, please see overleaf for details.

Pupils must wear the full school uniform to school every day. The uniform is suitable to wear for P.E. and any other sporting activities that the pupils are involved with.

Please note:

Shorts: Navy shorts may be worn on warm days during May and June. The shorts must be close to the knee length. Skin-tight shorts, cycling shorts or short shorts are not appropriate in school and should not be worn.

Footwear: Runners/sports shoes are permitted to wear with school uniform.

Hoodies/leggings (without the school crest): Are not part of the school uniform.

As per our code of behaviour it is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their children wear the correct school uniform, failure to wear the correct school uniform is deemed as a minor misbehaviour.

Students on work experience may wear clothes suitable for their work experience (as per guidelines from companies)

A written notification on Aladdin will be sent to parents if for whatever reason the school uniform is not required, for example, class birthdays, days out etc.
